 - **Artwork accepted to the exhibition, to be removed after the exhibition closes:**
 - Monday – Tuesday, July 22 – 23, 12 – 4 p.m., from the Anne Bryan Gallery
 - Wednesday – Thursday, July 24 – 25, 12 – 4 p.m. from the CE Office (3rd Floor, Hamilton Bldg.)
 - Friday, July 26, 10 a.m. – 1 p.m. from the CE Office (3rd Floor, Hamilton Bldg.)
 - Saturday, July 27, 12 – 4 p.m. from the CE Office (3rd Floor, Hamilton Bldg.)
 - **Artwork not picked up, or arranged to be picked up, after July 27 may be discarded.**
